Reward Requirements

- The display must be a model railroad diorama or module in any scale and be at least 4 square feet in area. Multiple modules that are joined together to create a single scene only count as one display.
- The display must be considered "complete" in that all major construction has been completed and scenery is in place.
- All submissions must have been completed within the last year.
- A member may only receive two awards for displays a year.
- Displays which are the property of the Division, or have been partially funded by the Division, are not eligible.
- The Division member, or the group the Division member is part of, must have a sign advertising Division 5 membership and have NMRA pamphlets available.
- Accepted public showings include Division 5's Railfest, NMRA shows and conventions, Lake Farm Park
 Christmas and Spring set-ups, Willoughby Frontier Days, and Burton Thanksgiving set-up. The Division
 officers will determine what is an accepted public showing in addition to those listed. It is the Division
 member's choice as to which of these events the display is shown.
- The Division officers or their selected representatives have final approval of the awards.
