



Division 5 Fleamarket Table Item Rules

If you want to make use of the Division fleamarket table at Railfest, you MUST fill out a Division 5 Railfest Fleamarket Table Items list. A copy of this form is included with this Trainwire. Copies will also be available at the February and March Division 5 meetings. The form can also be found on the Division 5 website. Use as many copies of the form as needed to list ALL the items you are selling. Each item on the table must have a sticker that contains the member's initials and a sequence number corresponding to the items on the form. Multiple items, bagged or boxed, are only counted as one item if they are being sold as a set.

Please keep prices in even dollar increments (\$1, \$2, \$3, etc.) if at all possible. This makes it a lot easier for the people manning the table to make change and handle the money.

Also, you need to provide a Business Size envelope to put the money in from the sales of your items. Mark your name clearly on the envelope. You also need to put some money in the envelope to allow the people manning the table to use for making change. We would like at least ten \$1 bills in the envelope. Please mark on the envelope the amount of money you provided for making change.



Div 5 BOD Meeting Minutes

A Division 5 BOD meeting was held on January 17, 2011 at Hambden Town Hall. Those present were Eric Hansmann, Bonnie Lette, Wayne Lette, Matt Kross, Don Bittner, Dale Smith, Bruce Lutheran, and Jim Wendorf.

- Railfest Chairman Jim Wendorf provided an update on the Railfest 2011 planning:
 - 205 out of roughly 410 tables have been sold so far.
 - The second set of invitations will go out shortly to 25 more dealers.
 - We may increase the number of tables this year since we are adding the two handball courts to our show space.
 - There was a question about what records we need to maintain regarding our dealers' vendors licenses. We will inform our dealers that they need to provide us with a copy of their vendors license or at least provide us their vendors license number.
 - We will hold our meeting with Railfest volunteers probably the first Monday in March.
 - We will get a list of all the Railfest jobs into the March Trainwire.
 - We will only be giving the exhibitors a maximum of 15 free badges. The remaining members of their group will get a discounted entrance fee.
 - We will be doing similar advertising as last year.
 - 1200 fliers were mailed to dealers.
- Jim Wendorf needs a copy of the 2010 Railfest audit report for the Railfest records.
- Matt Kross and Dale Smith provided an update on the 2011 Rails Of Ages convention:
 - Next convention planning meeting will be on January 22.
 - Convention information has been published in the Winter MCR Kingpin and been placed on the convention website.
 - We are ready to send out door prize donation requests to manufacturers and dealers.
 - Convention shirts for the volunteers will be ordered within the next month.
 - We are getting pricing on a convention pin.
 - Working on getting the times set for all events.
 - Assembling list of all equipment and supplies we will need.
 - Dale Smith went to the Division 9 January meeting to promote our convention.
 - Since there was dissatisfaction with convention co-chair Matt Kross' statement that we may bump Division members from tours if there are non-members that want to go on the tour, the convention committee will review what our policy will be.
- A motion was passed to donate the Walthers HO Turntable owned by the Division to the convention raffle.
- Motion passed to purchase approximately 80 batteries for our radios that will be used at Railfest and the convention.
- Discussed upcoming meeting programs and Bring & Brag themes. The February meeting program will be tarp covered gondola loads put on by Eric Hansmann.
- Discussed the Division 50th anniversary plans. We are considering several possible dates for our celebration. The earliest would be in late May, but it will more likely be in the August to October timeframe. We are checking on what facilities are available and that are affordable.

- We received a notice from the Ohio Attorney General's office that we need to register our group as a charitable organization and submit various documentation by February 28, 2011. We are checking to see if we are exempt from this. If not, we will assemble the needed documentation and perform the registration.
- At the February Div 5 BOD meeting, we will discuss various funding requests submitted by outside groups.
- A number of Division 5 members are ready to submit requests for our New Display Awards.
