

# Division 5 Meeting Minutes

May 2, 2014

Meeting was called to order by Assistant Superintendent Dave Neff at 7:30 pm at Lake Farmpark. There were 38 members and 5 guests present.

·New member Mike Rudder introduced himself.

·Div 5 election results: Dave Neff will be the new Superintendent. Dale Smith will be the Assistant Superintendent. They officially start their new positions on June 1, 2014.

·Div 4 has invited Div 5 members to join them on a bus trip to Altoona, PA on Saturday Aug 2. Cost is \$20 and reservations due by May 10<sup>th</sup>. The trip includes stops at the Altoona Railroaders Memorial museum, Horseshoe Curve Historic Site, and the Gallitzin Tunnels. The bus will depart from an area of Brecksville to maximize the time in the Altoona area. Lunch and Dinner are included in the cost. Contact Bruce Bowie of Div 4 to make reservations. Information is on the Div 4 website.

·Jim Wendorf, Railfest Chairman, gave a big round of thanks to all those that volunteered at this year's Railfest. The final financial report is still being worked on but we did well this year.

·This meeting was the last time orders could be placed through Div 5 for the 2014 NMRA National Convention hats. The hats should be available by our June meeting.

·Paper copies of the Div 5 Spring 2014 Layout Tour Guide were available at the meeting. A PDF copy was e-mailed to the Div 5 member e-mail list. There are 11 layouts that will be open.

·Dave Neff provided an update on the current status of the 2014 NMRA National Convention. E-mail updates are being sent out about new tours and promoting tours which aren't selling well. Some tours may be cancelled if there aren't enough people signed up to cover the tour cost. The train show and its layouts are outside of the control of the convention committee. They are handled by the national office. We have received some details about setup times, vehicle access, and parking for trailers/trucks.

·Scenic Express trip is scheduled for Saturday June 7. We need to be there at 10:30am. Those wanting to carpool should meet at Dale Smith's house for a departure at 7:30am sharp. Details will be in the June Trainwire. *(5/15/2014 update –the trip has been cancelled due a scheduling conflict at Scenic Express.)*

Harley and Dale Smith have purchased an HO collection and are selling off the items. Contact them to make an appointment to view the items.

Program: The evening's program was a discussion on modules and module construction. The Lake-Geauga HO Module Group showed their new module design and discussed the reasons for the design, materials used, and methods of construction. They showed a number of examples of the different components. Information on the new modules:

Generic frame with interchangeable drop-in scenery sections. Modules fit together with tongue and groove for consistent alignment. Mainline tracks are on a wood base. Scenery inserts use ½" aluminum-backed foam. Module length of 45". Module leg units easy to adjust and are shared between modules. Modules will mate with NMRA standard designs. 20 frames have been built – still need to build the corner modules. All new units are three track. Basic frame costs \$32.

May 12, 2014

A **Division 5 BOD meeting** was held on May 12, 2014 at Hambden Town Hall. In attendance were Dave Neff, Bonnie Lette, Wayne Lette, Don Bittner, Ted Wiese, Matt Kross, Bob Frieden, Bob Gittinger, Tom Pescha, Dale Smith, and Dennis Lloyd.

**Dennis Lloyd**, our election Teller, reported on the final Division 5 2014 election results. Out of the 79 ballots mailed, 61 were received back. The new officers for the June 1, 2014 to June 1, 2016 term are: Superintendent – **Dave Neff**; Assistant Superintendent – **Dale Smith**. The Clerk will notify the Mid Central Region of the changes.

Reminder that the annual **Mid Central Region membership meeting** will be on Saturday, June 14 in Marion, Ohio. All Division 5 members are encouraged to attend. Besides the meeting, there will be clinics and railfanning. Details will be in the MCR Kingpin.

At the end of the **Division 5 officer terms**, the terms of all the appointed positions expire. Superintendent-elect Dave Neff is contacting the Division 5 members in these positions to see if they are willing to continue.

Reviewed the various **upcoming events and programs** for Division 5.

The **Division 5 2014 picnic** will once again be held at the Painesville Depot. It will be on Saturday, August 2nd, from 2pm to 6pm. Bring chairs and your camera. Tom Pescha has created a flier for the event that will be in the Trainwire.

A motion was passed to donate \$200 to the **Western Reserve Railroad Association – Painesville Railroad Museum** as a thank you for hosting our Division 5 picnic.

A motion was passed for Division 5 to reimburse Division 5 members who have to pay for parking while volunteering at the **2014 NMRA National Convention in Cleveland**. The Division will pay up to \$10 per day to members who have a valid parking receipt (no copies) and have officially logged 4 volunteer hours at the convention for that day.

Matt Kross and Dale Smith provided an update on the current **2014 NMRA National Convention** planning status.

Information on the **2014 NMRA National Train show** modular layout setups is now being received and will be distributed to the module groups.

There is a question as to whether Division 5 is going to sell our **Company Store merchandise** at the 2014 NMRA National Convention company store. This still needs to be decided. One drawback is that we will have to pay a commission (usually 10%) which wipes out our profit on the items. However, it is a way to get rid of some of our inventory.

Concerns were raised about the **Trainwire** not getting out in time for our meetings.

Don Bittner reported that the **Chesterland Historical Society** has a nice interurban display. Don recently donated a box of Cleveland, Painesville & Eastern memorabilia to the group.

The next **Division 5 BOD meeting** will be held at Hambden Town Hall on June 9, 2014 at 7:30 pm.


