## Superintendent's Report

### NMRA Convention in Portland

The convention this year was Aug. 23-Aug. 30--too late to make a report for the Sept. Trainwire, so here goes...

Somewhere between 1300-2000 model railroaders and guests attended. There was a good crop of clinics, and unlike our convention in Cleveland many were repeated. There was an especially good series of 4 clinics on DCC. I'll have these available for download and get them onto our Division website in due course. Several other clinics (3) laid out the story on LCC Layout command control. This is simply a parallel system which takes the burden off of the burgeoning DCC bus and allows the myriad of other things; signals, lights, turnout controls, etc, to be independent of track bus DCC information, which should free up the DCC system to do what it can do best, transmit information to run trains without other interference. However, it is up to us as consumers to tell manufacturers what we want. To date there are only two vendors who are supplying control logic packages - RR Cirkits, and ModelControlSystems.

As part of the EduTrain team I and the leader, Bob Blake, identified a couple dozen clinics

which we want to become 'certified' for EduTrain. This will increase the stable of deliverable clinics for Division meetings that are capable of being presented with a little practice.

I ran into old acquaintance Jim Zinser, MMR, who writes the Division Business Car section for the bi-monthly NMRA magazine. I discussed with him the successful Lincoln Train Event which we co-sponsored, and the outcome of creating good visibility for the Depot as a civic asset. He suggested I write this up, which I did and have submitted. It should appear in December.

I and my roommate—Dave Williams of Div. 4, went on a tour of Hull-Oakes Sawmill, one of the last to be steam-operated. Very interesting, but now running solely by electricity as one-hundred year old steam equipment became unreliable and with new parts being unavailable.

As many of you know, the Portland convention team adopted Wayne Lette's computerized Silent Auction program, which they had initial difficulty with because their people didn't engage with it properly and in advance of the convention. However, with some long distance help from Wayne, eventually all went well. The auction

items themselves did not have the volume of Cleveland, but there was a good selection of high valued material, so the Portland convention did make money.

The train show was held in a more remote, older expo center versus the newer, closer-to-the convention-hotel because of cost. Needed to take two trains to get there but Portland has an excellent mass transit system, so it was very easy. As in the past, fewer and fewer vendors this time mainly West Coast vendors, and the usual main manufacturers. Still possible to spend money, however! Next year, the convention is in Indianapolis, so hopefully many of our Division 5 members can attend. - Dave







# A Division 5 Road Trip




