

Division 5 Membership Meeting Minutes

March 7, 2025

The March 7, 2025 membership meeting was held at Hambden Township Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by Superintendent Bill Osborne. There were 26 members and 6 guests present.

Railfest 2025 update was provided. Still waiting for Lakeland Community College to give us the dates for Railfest 2026. The television spot on TV8's New Day Cleveland show is all set for Friday, March14. Railfest job signup sheets are available on the Division website and at the meeting. The new vests have been received. Reviewed the various setup times for each day. At the moment, there are 9 tables left but we are still receiving calls from people that would like a table so we are hopeful that they will all be sold.

We are looking into a trip to the Age of Steam Roundhouse on September 20, 2025. Overall cost would be approximately \$3,000 for tickets and a bus so we may need to charge around \$50 per person. We need to set a reservation cutoff date and it looks it will need to be the June 2025 meeting. More information as the details are worked out.

The Division will no longer be sending out paper copies of the Trainwire starting with the April 2025 issue. Only the electronic PDF version of the Trainwire will be available. This will allow more flexibility and a larger size for our newsletter. We will be able to put more and larger pictures in the Trainwire as well as provide show fliers full-size. We will not be trying to embed videos. Instead, members are encouraged to post any videos they have on our Division 5 Face Book page.

Pictures that are contained in the Trainwire will still be available separately on the Division 5 website. The pictures will now remain available for 6 months after they are posted. Pictures will also be posted to the Division Face Book page.

The plan for our May program are virtual layout tours. We will show photos provided by members of either their own layouts or layouts they have visited. Bryan Persing will put the photo show together and needs your photo submissions by April 28, 2025 in order to prepare the presentation for the May meeting. Send your pictures to Trainwire@mcr5.org. Remember, if you submit pictures, you will receive a \$5 Division 5 Award Certificate and, if you submit a write-up along with the pictures, you will receive a \$10 certificate.



After the TCA York show this past October, as I made my way back to Northeast Ohio, I took a small day side trip through Altoona to spend the day seeing the horseshoe curve. I have never been here and it was definitely on my bucket list. Also this was near peak fall foliage so the colors where just perfect. Upon arriving I first explored a small museum which was very informative; giving a history lesson on the reason and the history behind building of the curve.


After my history lesson it was time to make my way up the long staircase (the lift was broken and inoperable that day) to get as close to the rails

as allowed. It didn't take long before the first train passed through on this sunny Sunday morning. The first one was an Amtrak passenger train; number 86. Also seen that day, during my four hours of railfanning, were a couple of double stacks, auto carriers, a very long coal train, and even a MOW train. Spectators were even gifted twice that day by seeing both eastbound and westbound trains passing at the same time. If you are ever close to Altoona, Pennsylvania I highly recommend a stop at the curve and even more so in the fall.



AIRTHCILIES

Ohio and Eastern Railroad

This 12"x12" HOn30 micro-layout encompasses an area from the flat farmlands of Ohio to the moun- tains of Pennsylvania. The farm in the lower left corner is in far western Ohio and is represented by the chicken coop. The rest of the large farm didn't fit, of course, and is off the layout. The abandoned coal mine is in the mountains of Pennsylvania about 450 miles to the east. The center displays a coal-fired power plant in a rust-belt city, possibly Youngstown. The railroad services many places along the route, carrying livestock, produce especially Ohio tomatoes), eggs, dairy products, cheese and milk from the farms to points east, and coal to points west.


I started in the hobby building static dioramas, on which I enjoyed doing detailed scenery. About 15 years ago a friend invited us to a meeting of the Mini-Bunch, a group of Midwest narrowgauge modelers. Some of their displays were microlayouts, and I liked the idea of creating a small fullydetailed layout with an operating train. I was encouraged by one of the members, Russ Haigh, to try making a pizza layout in HOn30. He handed me a board with some n-scale track and I was hooked!

I started by building and painting the CON-COR Cambria Boiler House kit retrieved from a shelf in our basement, then searched flea markets and train shows for leftover parts and small structures. The car is from a SceneMasters set. At a train show I bought the chicken coop missing the door, so I made a door and then added some chickens and the farmer from my collection of unpainted figures. Everything was first painted with inexpensive acrylic craft paints before placing on the layout. The water tower was from an n-scale layout being dismantled, which I painted, swapped the ladder with an HO ladder, and then added an HO figure and a chain. The lighted maintenance building was a left-over part of another kit to which I added an interior and many details. The abandoned mine is a carved piece of pink foam with the recessed entrance door painted black and covered with a piece of brokendown fence and a warning sign.

The scenery is a carved-foam road cut with super-tree bushes on the hillside behind the power house, and coarse dirt, ballast (also used as gravel), ground foam in several colors, coal and assorted debris elsewhere on the layout. The steam engine is a small HOn30 from MicroTrains that pulls an assortment of coal cars and an open load. I use a switch box containing a 9-volt battery for power to make it portable. This square-footer draws a lot of interest at train shows, flea markets and conventions.




