

Division 5 Membership Meeting Minutes

April 4, 2025

Vendors said they had a good weekend. General public comments were that they were glad we got rid of the wristbands. It helped to speed up the processing at the gate. The new gate booth was well received.

The details for our trip to the Age of Steam Roundhouse on Saturday, September 20, 2025, are being worked on. We are looking into transportation options. We need to get an accurate count of how many people will be going.

Looking at possibilities for the Division picnic this summer.

The plan for our May program is a virtual layout tour. We will show photos provided by members of either their own layouts or layouts they have visited. Bryan Persing will put the photo show together and needs your photo submissions by April 28, 2025 in order to prepare the presentation for the May meeting. Send your pictures to Trainwire@mcr5.org. Remember, if you submit pictures, you will receive a \$5 Division 5 Award Certificate and, if you submit a write-up along with the pictures, you will receive a \$10 certificate.

The April Trainwire was the first month where we have gone to a digital version only. No more paper copies will be mailed out or provided. This allows us to expand on the content of the Trainwire.

Upcoming programs: May will be the Virtual Layout Tour, June will be Scratchbuilding Part 2, no meeting in July, and August will be on Chasing the UP Big Boy. Looking for programs for September and October.

MINIUTES

BOD Meeting 14 April 2025

A Division 5 BOD meeting was held on April 14, 2025. The meeting was held online using Zoom. In attendance were Bill Osborne, Bryan Persing, Bonnie Lette, Mike Carovac, Chuck Limbert, Matt Kross, Linda Kacprzak, Doug Riedel, and John Ward.

Reviewed how Railfest 2025 went. Still missing the Lakeland Community College bill. Looks like our profit this year will be a little less than last year. The profit will essentially be the amount of grant money we receive from the visitor's bureau. We had some higher expenses this year because of some investments that were made in new equipment such as vests and the ticket booth. We had lower table sales and lower attendance (about 100 less) than last year. We will probably eliminate the shuttle bus next year due to the lack of use. Want to do more things online next year and reduce postage costs. John was thanked for a successful first year.

Reviewed the details for the trip to the Age Of Steam Roundhouse / Warther Museum. This will be an all-day trip on Saturday, Sep 20, 2025 at a cost of \$50/person. The cost goes towards the two entrance fees (Age Of Steam Roundhouse, Warther Museum), lunch, and the transportation. Division 5 will cover any costs that the \$50/person does not cover. Members may bring as many guests as you would like at a cost of \$50/person but we need a definite count of the number of guests. The Division will provide the transportation which will either be a bus or some passenger vans, depending on the number of people that are going. We most likely will depart from somewhere in Chardon, OH. You have the option of driving yourself and we will provide directions and the itinerary. However, even if you drive yourself, the cost per person remains the same at \$50/person. We will need to know how many people will be making use of the Division transportation. The proposed itinerary will be as follows: Leave Chardon, tour the Warther Museum, have lunch, tour the Age Of Steam Roundhouse, arrive back in Chardon.

Discussed liability coverage of modular groups that are not a part of Division 5. Since these groups are totally separate from the NMRA and Division 5, Division 5 has no liability responsibility. The separate group would need to be a 100% NMRA club to get insurance from the NMRA. The Division decided a number of years ago that we no longer want to specifically sponsor a module group and thus show favoritism to a specific scale.

The next Div 5 BOD meeting will be on Monday, June 9, 2025, at 7:30pm online using Zoom. (Note: Normally, BOD meetings are held on even numbered months from February to October and then in November and not in December.)

Scale Rails of Southwest Florida

Back in November I made a trip to my Florida home to take all the hurricane protection off and get it ready for our snowbird renters. While down there I am always on the lookout for train related activities in the area and I found another hidden gem about 20 minutes from my home in Fort Myers. This hidden gem is known as Scale Rails of Southwest Florida. They are open for visitors on Tuesdays and Saturdays and my travels brought me here on a Tuesday afternoon. I was cordially greeted by a gentleman whose name now escapes me and he was my guide for all things club related. I got a general tour and history of the "depot" as they call it but once they found out I was an NMRA member that is when the real tour began. Now being an O gauger most of the technical stuff was very foreign to me but one can still appreciate all the hard work and technical expertise that went into designing the command control of the HO layout. I came away with a deep respect

for what the 40+ members have achieved on this highly detailed club layout.

The other item I found fascinating is that the "depot" is completely club owned. This is the biggest issue that most clubs fear is losing their locations or leases. Scale Rails had this happen some years ago so the club decided to find and purchase their own permanent location and building. They then worked diligently paying off the mortgage through shows, donations, and dues. They are now completely club owned and don't have to worry about moving again. I would try to describe all the great scenes but I took enough photos that you can see their quality workmanship from the picture displays.

If you ever get to southwest Florida they would love to show you around and talk trains for an hour or two. This will definitely be on my repeat list as they are continuing to work and expand scenes on the club layout. You can read more about them at www.scalerails.org/index.html






