

BOD Meeting 10 June 2024

A Division 5 BOD meeting was held on June 10, 2024. The meeting was held online using Zoom. In attendance were Bill Osborne, Bonnie Lette, Wayne Lette, Bryan Persing, Mike Carovac, Chuck Limbert, Matt Kross, Linda Kacprzak, Andy Yedlick, John Ward, Paul Emch, and Ted Wiese.

We gained one new member this month. John Karwoski from Montville. We currently have 7 members overdue for renewal. They are being contacted.

Matt Kross will get some information and quotes on a quality printed Division 5 / NMRA advertising sign along with a tabletop stand.

Mike Carovac has accepted being a Division 5 Director.

All existing Division coordinators have agreed to continue for another term.

Matt needs to send the region the current list of officers and contact information.

The Division 5 Railfest Planning Committee members are currently John Ward (chairman), Doug Riedel, and Cody Cavender. The committee will meet after the July 4th holiday to begin work on Railfest 2025. Still waiting to get the laptop from Jim. Jim still needs to close out items for Railfest 2024.

- The BOD decided that the Railfest Planning Committee chairman should be a member of the Division 5 Board Of Directors. We will need to modify the Division Regulations to add the Railfest Chairman as a member of the BOD. This position will be set up similar to the Trainwire Editor.
- We need to get the signatures changed on our bank accounts now that we have new officers and Railfest chairman. It was asked if we need to have the officers on the accounts or can it be the Treasurer and Clerk, which are not changing as often. The BOD decided that the signatures should remain as we have been doing where the bank accounts have the Treasurer, Superintendent, and Assistant Superintendent as authorized signatures.
- The BOD authorized the Treasurer to proceed with moving up to \$50,000 of Division savings into higher yield safe investments such as CD's. The BOD gives the Treasurer discretion with determining what investments to use, what the duration of the investment will be, and the amount to transfer.
- Looking for meeting programs starting in September. We have the option of getting someone remote to do a program via Zoom. We also can revert to showing a video. We may be able to show a clinic from the NMRAx library. If we can find a video player that will work with our library of NMRA clinic DVD's, we could start showing some of those.

- The BOD decided they want to try somewhere else to hold the Division family picnic. It was suggested we try to do something with the Lake Shore Live Steamers at Penitentiary Glen Park. Andy Yedlick will check with the LSLS to see if there is something we can do. Another thought was to do something with the Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad. Bill Osborne will see if he can come up with something.
- The BOD approved revising the Division's New Display Award requirements to only require a minimum area of 1 square foot so that T-Trak modules will qualify for the award.
- The continued review of the Division 5 Regulations was tabled until the August meeting. It was agreed that the revised wording will finally be resolved at the August 12 BOD meeting, one way or another. If the BOD cannot agree on the wording, the proposed revisions will be dropped.
- The next Div 5 BOD meeting will be on Monday, August 12, 2024, at 7:30pm online using Zoom. (Note: Normally, BOD meetings are held on even numbered months from February to October and then in November and not in December.)

Division 6 of the NMRA Mid-Central Region is currently offering an HO scale 41' gondola lettered for Buckeye Steel Castings.

Buckeye Steel was a large steel foundry located in Columbus, Ohio. They produced castings of numerous railroad components, including trucks, couplers and, the famous "Buckeye Truck." These gondolas moved scrap as well as finished products. Interchange partners included C&O and NYC, both railroads having trackage leading into the plant complex.

These car kits are from Accurail's 3700-series of steel gondolas with road number 23. Decals for six other road numbers are available for those ordering more than one car.

Pricing is \$27 per car. Shipping (via USPS Priority) is \$10 for one car and \$17 for two to three cars. Ohio residents, please add 7.5% sales tax on the total price of the kits and the shipping/handling fee. Customers outside the USA, please contact us for shipping arrangements and charges.



MCR Kingpin Editor Needed




